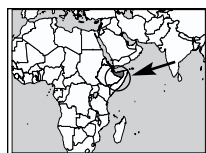

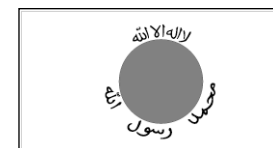

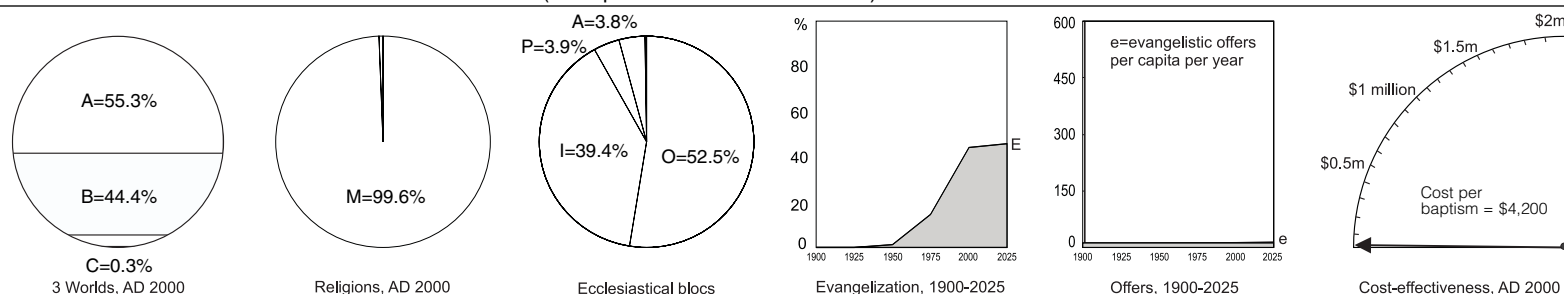

Percentages may not always total exactly, due to rounding.

NOTES ON RELIGIONS
PROFESSING CHRISTIANS. Mainly French and British expatriates. Also Ethiopian refugees.

INDEPENDENTS. Isolated radio believers scattered across the country and unrelated to existing denominations.

MUSLIMS. Mostly Hanafite Sunnis.

Country status. Somaliland, formerly a British overseas protectorate, is a north-eastern African country bordering the Indian Ocean near the opening of the Gulf of Suez. The population is largely engaged in nomadic stock-raising.

HUMAN LIFE AND LIBERTY

This territory suffers from most of the inadequacies of the parent republic of Somalia. Nevertheless it has escaped the terrible famines and civil wars of further south.

NON-CHRISTIAN RELIGIONS

Islam is the religion of almost the entire population.

CHRISTIANITY

Only a few Christians have been able to live and worship openly.

CATHOLIC CHURCH The Holy See has no diplomatic relations with Somaliland in AD 2000.

Indigenous missions. No missionaries have been sent out from the fledgling church in Somaliland.

FUTURE TRENDS AND PROSPECTS

Few changes are expected in the religious situation in Somaliland before 2025.

Christians will be unlikely to reach 1% of the population before the mid-century. Islam will predominate throughout the period.
